Both data are essential to count the potential volume of generated biodiesel in the state of Mato Grosso do Sul and especially the volume of glycerol to be produced through transesterification. Through determined volume of glycerol, production of hydrogen for energy purposes is possible. This fuel could be used in generator such as fuel cells. Indeed the potential energy generations could be determined.
